Substances in this list do not include: medications prescribed by a doctor taken in the prescribed dosage.

Substances referred to in this list include those that you:

- consume more often than the doctor has prescribed for you
- consume because you want to have fun, feel good, get "high", or wonder what sort of effect they have on you
- have received from a relative or a friend
- bought on the "black market" or stolen
